Reading Schemes Overview

Our school promotes a love of reading. We provide a text rich environment for all of our pupils. We have a well-stocked library and central reading area stocked with a wide variety of books from many different schemes, so that we can cater for the different learning styles of all our pupils.

All our books are labelled and sorted into coloured book bands. Guided reading texts are also used at the appropriate level to enhance progression. This helps us monitor the reading progression of our pupils throughout their entire school life.

All classrooms have an interesting, relevant book area, which includes fiction and non-fiction books, which reflect the diverse culture of our school. Provision is made for those with English as an additional language and those with Special Education Needs and Disabilities to be able to access the school's books.

Now that a large proportion of reading is completed on-screen, we also work hard with computer literacy and students are encouraged to pursue a passion for reading in every format, from tablet to desktop to audiobooks.

We use a range of reading materials, which include:

- Guided Reading Texts
- In KS2, children are encouraged to choose their own texts of a suitable level and both guided and shared reading opportunities aid comprehension.
