Using both analogue and digital clocks, comparing and finding the difference between times. Remembering known angles to work out missing angles.</p>	<p>What you can could do to help: Practise memorising and using grammatical terms – using their tool kits. Read a variety of books and texts regularly. Discuss what your child is reading to ensure they have understood the text.</p>
