

<p>Maths Place value – representing numbers, compare and order, rounding, roman numerals. Four Operations- formal written and mental methods for multiplication, division, addition and subtraction. Fractions- simplify fractions, fractions on a number line, compare and order, add and subtract, mixed addition and subtraction, multiply and divide, four rules with fractions, fractions of an amount.</p>	<p>English Sentences- nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, simple, compound and complex, subject and objects, main and subordinate clauses. Punctuation- capital letters, full stops, commas, exclamation marks, question marks, speech marks, inverted commas, hyphens, dashes, brackets, colons and semi-colons. Focus on a range of text types: fiction, letters, non-chronological reports, short stories with flashbacks, balanced and biased arguments, debates and persuasion.</p>	
<p>What you can could do to help: Practise times tables regularly. Practise powers of 10 and multiplying by 10, 100 and 1000. As well as practising calculations regularly using formal written methods, also practise answering calculations mentally.
