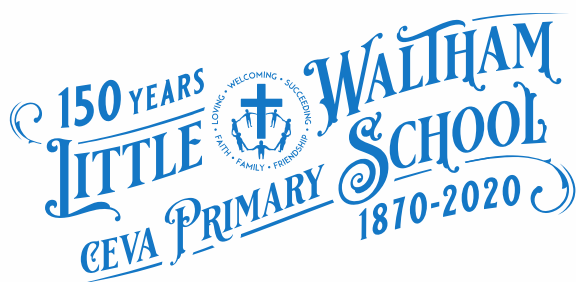

This week's value is Creation.



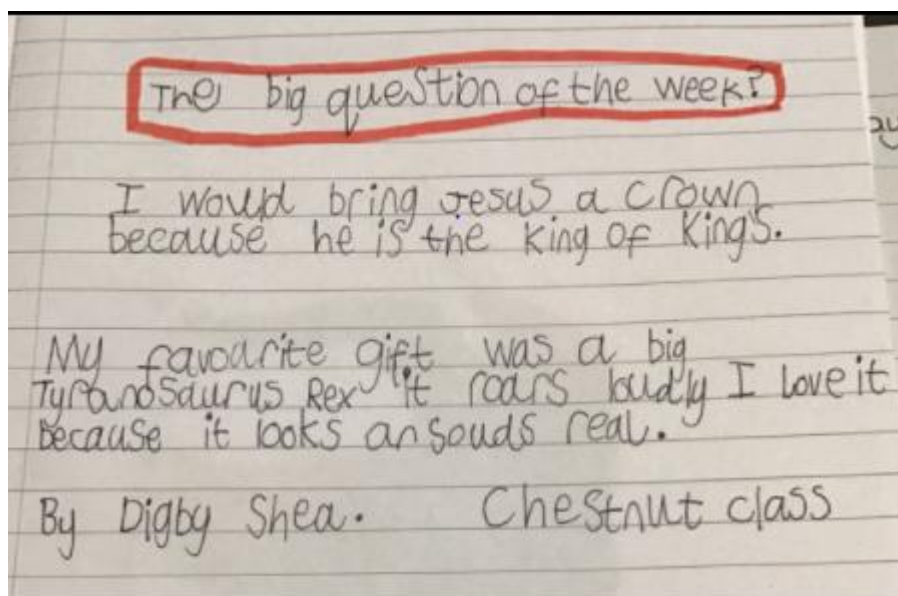
Dear God,
