

<p><b>Maths</b> In Summer 1, we will begin our Fractions topic. As part of this topic, we will be learning to identify halves, thirds and quarters of objects, images and numbers.</p> <p>After this, we will move onto Position and Direction. We will be learning to describe position and direction using prepositional language and describing movement using fractional language.</p> <p>In Summer 2, we will be learning about time. We will be learning to tell the time to the hour, half past the hour and telling the time to five minutes.</p> <p>After this, we will move onto our Shape topic where we will learn to recognise 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.</p>	<p><b>English</b> In Spring 1 our topic is the Great Fire of London. We will be learning about the fire and writing about it.</p> <p>In Spring 2, our topic is At the Seaside. We will be reading Mrs Armitage and the Big Wave by Quentin Blake as well as other books related to the seaside and completing reading and writing tasks related to these.</p>	
<p><b>What you can do to help:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Make children familiar with prepositional language such as: above, below, under, in between, etc.</li> <li>• Play games that involve children making quarter, half and full turns.</li> <li>• Explain the minute and hour hand of a clock to children and begin getting them to identify the time to the hour</li> </ul>	<p><b>What you can do to help:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Read regularly with your child, asking them to recall what they have read, what they think will happen next, what unknown words and phrases mean and to give reasons for character's feelings and motives.</li> <li>• Encourage your child to begin using exclamation sentences in everyday use: What a lovely day it is! How beautiful that flower is!</li> </ul>
